(lessons and extra-curricular)



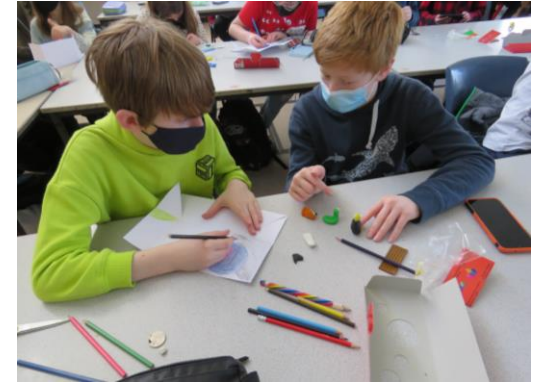
THE TUTORS' ROLE ...

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

ATTENDANCE

- Our expectation is 100% attendance
- Attendance below 95% will be chased

SCHOOL RESTAURANT

- Our current Year 7 are ordering food via an app and have it delivered to The Edge where their bubble has been located
- In September, all being well, we will revert back to having all year groups using the school restaurant
- The restaurant uses a biometric system using each child's finger print
- Students will be registered for the system during their first day



SCHOOL RESTAURANT

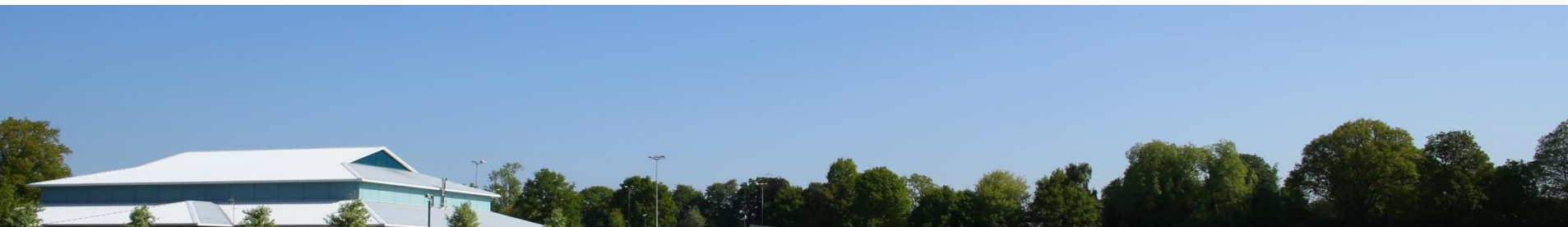
- Accounts can be topped up online
(information will be given at start of term)
- Purchases can be tracked by parents
- ***All students will need a packed lunch for the first day only***



EQUIPMENT

Students will need a backpack/rucksack with them every day, with the following items:

- Pencil case
- Pens (*black or blue biro*)
- Pencils
- Pencil sharpener
- 30cm ruler
- Calculator
- Protractors
- Colouring pencils
- Pair of compasses
- Glue stick
- Green Pen
- Highlighters (*pink and green*)



MOBILE PHONES

- If a student brings a mobile phone into school it **MUST** be turned off and kept out of sight in their school bag when on the school site.
- If a student is seen with their phone out on the school site it will be confiscated. It can then be collected from the Engagement Office at the end of the day.
- However, for repeat offences the phone may be confiscated for a longer period and may only be returned to the parent



EXTRA-CURRICULAR & ENRICHMENT

- At the start of the new term students will attend our Freshers' Fair
- Students will be able to sign up to clubs after school and at lunchtime
- The programme will also be sent out to parents in September
- Any curriculum trips during the year will be notified in advance
- Year 7 camp will take place at the end of the summer term in July 2022

TRANSPORT

Students can get to school in the following ways:

- Walk
- Surrey County Council transport (*need to be meet eligibility criteria*)
- Zeelo Woolmer Hill transport (*routes and costs will be confirmed ASAP, and before the start of the autumn term*)
- Public bus from Haslemere



TRANSPORT

Students can also cycle to school:

- Our school is working with Surrey County Council on a travel plan, and Surrey are offering free places on a secondary school cycle training course for new Year 7 students.
- This course has been designed as a follow-on from Bikeability Level 2 training, furthering skills, knowledge and experience for your child to help them cycle to school if they wish to do so.
- The course will take place in the autumn term of the new academic year 2021/2022 and will be led by qualified Bikeability instructors under the guidance of Surrey County Council's Cycle Training Team.
- We will send an email with a link to complete by Friday 2nd July if you are interested in your child receiving one of these free places
